



UPDATED PHONE GUIDELINES

MOBILE PHONES AT SIENA COLLEGE

THE UNIVERSITY POLICY ON MOBILE PHONES:

Students are permitted to use mobile phones for educational purposes. However, the use of mobile phones for non-educational purposes is prohibited during class time and during school activities.

All mobile phone use is prohibited during class time, from 8:40 a.m. to 3:20 p.m.

Non-educational use of mobile phones during school activities is also prohibited.

Non-educational use of mobile phones during school activities is also prohibited.

Prohibited use of mobile phones during school activities includes, but is not limited to, using mobile phones for social media, texting, or playing games.

Teachers are responsible for enforcing this policy in their classrooms.

RECESS AND LUNCHTIME

Students are permitted to use mobile phones during recess and lunchtime for educational purposes.

Mobile phone use during recess and lunchtime is also permitted for non-educational purposes.

Prohibited use of mobile phones during recess and lunchtime includes, but is not limited to, using mobile phones for social media, texting, or playing games.
